Construction: GRP hull, deck and super structure. All windows renewed in 2008. Iron fin keel. Spade hung rudder with tiller steering. Removed, re-packed and re-fibre glassed in 2006.

Navigation, Electronics & Safety Equipment: Standard Horizon CP180 GPS with memory card for South Coast ports. Compass (renewed in August 2006). Simrad RT64 VHF radio. Simrad TP10 Autopilot. Bidata ST24 log, boat speed. indicator. Echo sounder renewed in 2006. Mast top wind direction indicator. Bow, stern and tri-colour navigation lights. Radar reflector. Whale manual bilge pump. 12 volt searchlight. 2 fire extinguishers. Offshore flares (need re-newing). Lifebuoy. Floating light. Danbuoy. Foghorns.

Sails: Mainsail, Dacron, new 2000. Serviced in 2010. Furling genoa, Dacron. Serviced in 2010.

Deck equipment: Plough anchor with 40 metres of galvanised chain. 5 fenders. 4 warps. Cockpit cover and tent. Lazy jack system. Spray hood. Boarding ladder. Boathooks (2). Spare Danforth anchor.

Spars & Rigging: Aluminium spar. Sloop rig. Slab reefing mainsail. Roller furling Genoa system. Standing rigging upgraded in 1994. Running rigging, Genoa, mainsail halyards and main sheet renewed in 2009. Three winches.

Addition equipment: Avon Redcrest inflatable dinghy with 3hp outboard.

Accommodation: 6 berths in 2 cabins. Headroom 5' 11". Separate heads compartment with manual Jabsco toilet and wash basin. Plastimo Neptune 2000 gas stove with 2 burners and grill. Cool box. Sink. Freshwater capacity 40 litres. Crockery and cutlery. Saloon upholstery replaced in 2002 but now needs further attention.

Comments: From surveyor in 2005: "Serendipity was found to be a well constructed yacht, which appears to have received regular maintenance. With the recommendations in this report carried out, and continued regular maintenance, she should provide many more years of sound and reliable service."

Owners comments: I purchased Serendipity in 2005. The surveyor's recommendations were carried out with only minor items outstanding (full report available). Woodwork completely renovated or renewed and maintained to a high standard. Old anti-foul coats were completely stripped off in 2010 before re-coating for the season. She handles well with good sea-keeping qualities.
